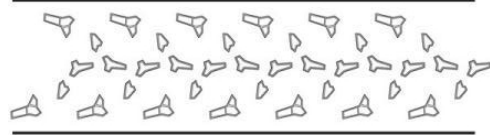

Race day registration opens at 10:30 am and will close 15 minutes prior to the start of each race. One-day and annual USAC licenses will be on sale.

Make checks payable to **918XCRacing**. Enter a second race on the same day for \$15. Racers can compete in only one category per race. Masters Racers must race in their appropriate age category. One-day license holders may not compete in the Men's 1/2/3 race.

Race will be held rain or shine. USA Cycling rules apply. All racers are required to have a current USAC license or purchase a license on race day. #### **From Downtown Tulsa**

Take Highway 64/412 West. Exit at North 33<sup>rd</sup> West Ave. Take North 33<sup>rd</sup> West Ave. to Apache and turn left (west) on Apache. Follow Apache into a hard right turn (north). Turn left (west) on West 31<sup>st</sup> Street North. After  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile, turn right into Post Oak Lodge entrance.

#### **From Oklahoma City**

Take I44 East into Tulsa. Go through the Turner Turnpike gate, and continue east until I-44 and I-244 split(exit 223). Stay left and follow signs to 244 East . Stay on 244 East to the downtown area. Take Highway 64/412 West. Exit at North 33<sup>rd</sup> West Ave. Take North 33<sup>rd</sup> West Ave. to Apache and turn left (west) on Apache. Follow Apache into a hard right turn (north). Turn left (west) on West 31<sup>st</sup> Street North. After  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile, turn right into Post Oak Lodge entrance.
