THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES WILL RECEIVE USAC MEDALS ONLY for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd:

- MEN CAT 5
- ALL MEN AND WOMEN'S AGE GROUPS BY 5 YEAR AGE GROUPS (35+) - USAC Rule 8G8(a)
- 20 K MEN (65+) and 20K Women (55+)

First place Merckx Category receives dinner for 2 from **Carinos Italian plus \$10 **Kamp's 1910** gift certificate. Second place receives dinner for 2 from **Carinos Italian**. Third place receives a \$10 gift card for **Kamp's 1910**:**

- OPEN Eddy Merckx division (NO aero helmet, disks, and bars. 60 mm max wheel rim depth)

DIRECTIONS TO COURSE: Take I-44 to Medicine Park exit about 5 miles north of Lawton; go west on Highway 49 approximately five miles to Highway 58. Turn North on Highway 58 and go one mile to start area. You will see the signs.

ENTRIES: All licensed racers from any state are eligible for cash prizes. ONLY Oklahoma racers are eligible for medals and Oklahoma State Championship jerseys. ONLY annual licensed Oklahoma racers are eligible for medals. Advanced registration will be available through **USA Cycling**. The advanced registration fee will be **\$20 plus \$2.50 online fee. Race Day registration will be \$30.**

Junior racers are **free for advance registration** and pay only the USA Cycling online fee. **Junior category Race Day registration is \$15.** Additional fee for one-day license (\$10) for non-USAC annual licensed riders, and such entrants are limited to Men's Cat 5, Master's, Eddy Merckx, Junior, 20K events, or Women's Cat 4 events with no medals or State Championship jerseys.

THE COURSE will take you over Stumbling Bear Pass, and by the historic Kimbell Ranch and up to the Blue Canyon wind farm. A map will be on the OKCVELO website. A direct link to the registration will be posted on the OKCVELO website, too.

RACE DAY REGISTRATION: Available from **7:45 AM to 8:45 AM** at the parking lot. Make checks payable to **OKC Velo Club**. Start time is **9:00 AM** for the 20K with riders going off at 1 minute intervals.

CLASSES:

All junior women and men race 20K; Start times begin at **9:00 AM**, subsequent riders at 1:00 intervals.

All 55+ master women and 65+ men race 20K, start times begin at **9:00 AM**, subsequent riders at 1:00 intervals.

All other riders will race 40K, start time at about **9:25 AM**, depending on the amount of 20K racers.

NEW! We plan to speed up awards by running the race in Category Order. Therefore for example, once the MEN 1/2 are done, results will be calculated, posted, and awarded as soon as possible without waiting for all others to finish first. However, the mandatory USAC five year age increment category (35 years and up) medals cannot be determined until all racers of most all categories are done. In order to allow racers to head home once their category has been finalized, we will arrange for an Oklahoma City or Tulsa pick-up of the medals the week after the event.

CASH BONUS: \$50 male and \$25 female bonus paid to the 40K distance Cat 1- 4 riders who post the overall fastest times. \$100 cash bonus paid to the individual rider(s) who posts an official time under the Oklahoma State 40K TT record of 52:44 for Men or the 40K TT record of 59:30 for Women. No one-day license entries are eligible for these awards.

RULES: All USAC 2011 rules are in effect, including the requirement of the wearing of a helmet; **reporting to the starting line at least 3 minutes prior to a person's designated start**; on an out and back course one must stay on their side of the road centerline; maintaining a drafting spread of 80 feet behind a rider or else moving 7 feet off to the side; and all other Section 3E requirements. Race to be held rain or shine, except for lightning delay. Only USAC regulation bicycles will be permitted.

Safety: This is an open course with wide shoulders and minimal curves. There is no need to be on or by the yellow line. Anyone seen impeding traffic in any way will be assessed time penalties.

Juniors will need to report before 8:15 AM on race day to have their gearing inspected for USAC compliance. If a junior does not know the details of this requirement, contact William.Wylie@gmail.com as many days before the race as possible. It is the Junior racer's responsibility to find the official for measurement. It is not the official's duty to find you.
